1. Almost 7,700 Consumer A and over 8,700 Provider A forms have been submitted to ODMH from Franklin County. SMD providers are getting 6-month follow up surveys (over 3,000 for each form). If a consumer terminates (or is terminated from) treatment without completing a termination survey, the case manager should still complete a Provider A for termination.
2. Termination is a complex issue for the SMD population. Some med somatic consumers are seen at longer intervals than other consumers. ADAMH will investigate the feasibility of obtaining termination information from the BH dataset.
3. The next round of CSQ-8 surveys will start soon.
4. Past data from the CSQ-8 surveys has been disseminated to each agency. The rounds correspond to the following time periods:
